Schools and Universities

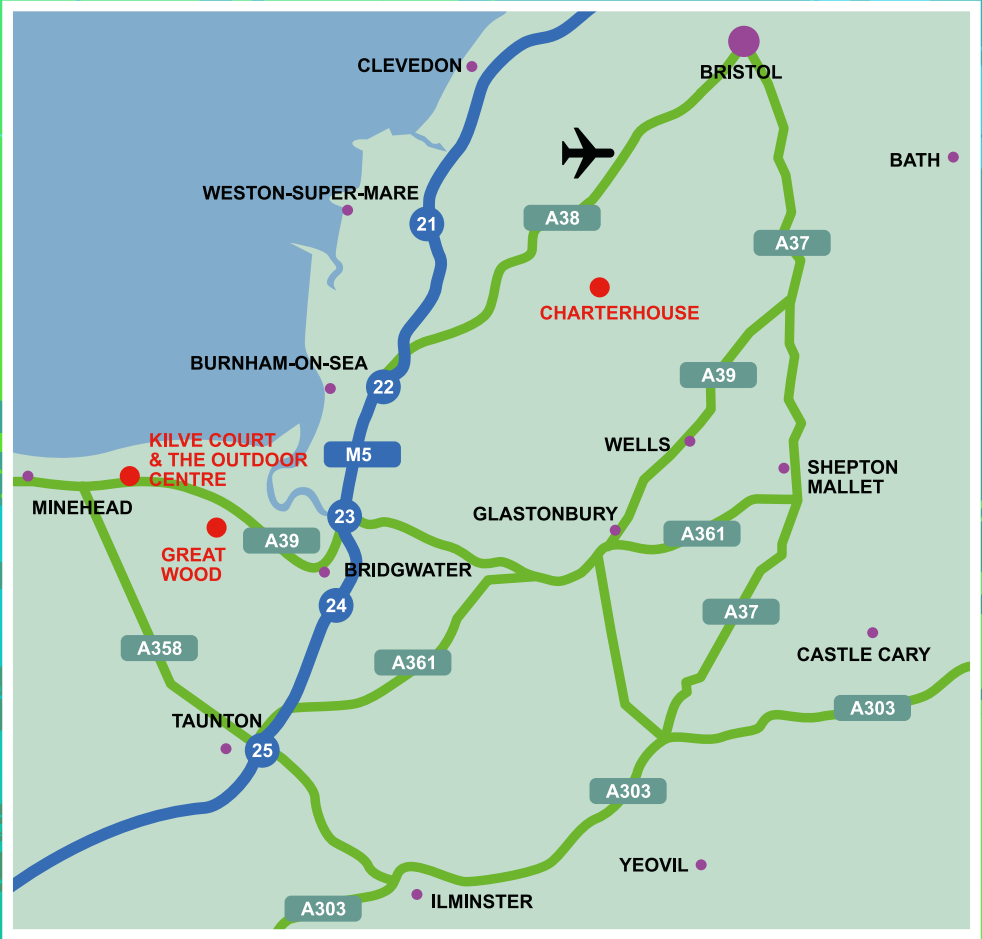

Support Services for Education Outdoors

We comprise of four stunning sites on the Mendip and Quantock Hills, all sympathetically tailored for outdoor learning. We have a proud, long history of delivering engaging and inspiring outdoor learning programmes for over 70 years in some of Somerset's most beautiful locations.

We take the needs of each individual student very seriously. We go to great lengths to make sure every single student who walks through our doors can safely challenge themselves, explore their unique abilities and facilitate their growth and development in an outdoor environment.



Charterhouse

Situated on the top of the Mendip Hills in one of Somerset's Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty, the Charterhouse Outdoor Centre has been providing school residential since the 60's! You'd be hard pressed to find someone who went to school in Somerset who doesn't have extremely fond memories of their time here! Perfectly located and superbly updated it is within walking distance of the spectacular Cheddar Gorge named as the second greatest natural wonder in Britain! Charterhouse offers the more usual exciting outdoor activities; however, it also offers the opportunity to get 'up close and personal' with the impressive local geology. Caving at Charterhouse allows exploration of the Mendip cave system evoking feelings of a Tolkien-esq landscape where there is always the possibility of spotting a Hobbit or even Gollum! The Outdoor Centre

A self-contained site within the grounds of Kilve Court, The Outdoor Centre has all the advantages of the activities available at Kilve Court itself but with much more of a camping vibe. Situated at the base of the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty on the Quantock Hills, accommodation for up to 76 people is provided in heated wood cabins with a central meeting and eating point in the beautiful Quantock Hall.
