## Payment / Terms and Conditions

The cost will be £170 per person and booked and payable through the SSE Outdoors website <u>Home (sseoutdoors.co.uk)</u>

## Dates – we will run the Training Day and Qualifying Expedition back-to-back.

## 21-23<sup>rd</sup> July 2025

Please arrive at 9am on 21<sup>st</sup> July at Kilve TA5 1EA – to meet everyone and sort kit as needed

- Please collect at 5pm TBC on 23<sup>rd</sup> July from Kilve TA5 1EA participants will confirm timings on the day.
- Day 1 training days 2&3 will be the assessed qualifying expedition.

## Food and Drink - each student must

Provide own breakfast for each full day

Provide snacks and packed lunches for **each** days.

Provide own evening meal for **each night**, This should be simple boil in the bag / pasta / rice type meals.

Water – each person must carry 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  litres of water – please bring own water bottles. These can be re filled at the campsite

SSE may decide to use technology as an integral part of the expedition for navigation, safety, recording the event as they see fit. This may include allowing students to utilise helpful aspects of mobile phones but will not take away from the need for good solid navigation.
