We will group the participants by award type and level on arrival

Payment / Terms and Conditions

The cost will be £260 per person and payable through the SSE Outdoors website [Home \(sseooutdoors.co.uk\)](https://sseooutdoors.co.uk)

Dates – we will run one expedition as a practice or a qualifier – you will hopefully have done training at your DofE centre before coming to Kilve, but we will re cap what is needed on day one also

Expedition – 5-9th April 2027

Please arrive at 2pm on 5th April at Kilve TA5 1EA – to sort kit as needed and do route cards

Please collect at 4pm TBC on 9th April from Kilve TA5 1EA

subject to all borrowed equipment being returned in a clean and tidy condition

Note - We will transport you to/from Exmoor for your expedition

Food and Drink - each participant must

Provide own breakfast for **each full** day

Provide snacks and packed lunches for **each** day.

Provide own evening meal for **each night**, This should be simple boil in the bag / pasta / rice type meals.

Water – each person must carry **2 litres of water** – please bring own water bottles. These can be re filled at the campsite and check points

Expedition food - The Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE) Shopping – please do not bring fresh meat products or food that will go off during the expedition!

School Staff / SSE Staff Levels

SSE Outdoors will provide supervisors for the duration of the expedition

Transport

Participants to make their own way to Kilve and be collected from Kilve.

Young people to confirm pick up time with parents on the last day.

SSE Outdoors will transport the group to and from Exmoor as part of the package

Kit

Please see kit list for more information on what to bring / wear / carry for the expeditions. If you have any questions, please ask.

Any personal equipment in yellow needed – can be organised on arrival

All group kit in green – will be provided by SSE Outdoors

Assessor

If you are using this expedition for your qualifier, there will be an assessor to do your DofE report and ensure DofE expeditions aims and requirements are being met. This will either be an external assessor or someone in the SSE Outdoors team

Additional points

SSE Outdoors reserve the right to cancel the expedition due to low numbers – less than one group! We will do this 48 hours before the event. We will then look to re book at a time that suits the group in the future.

SSE Outdoors will ask you to put mobile phones in sealed bags for the duration of the expedition, to ensure that they aren't used for navigation. So, if you wish to take pictures bring a standard camera. Mobile phones will be available for emergency contact only. Please do not carry additional battery packs or portable speakers

Day one will be at Kilve and Night one – nights 2-4 will be on Exmoor – SSE Outdoors will do the transport to Exmoor and get you back to Kilve for pick up

These routes are around 15km per day, over challenging terrain. So please think about this and personal fitness levels, before you arrive.

If you haven't done a previous level – please let us know

Please ensure your rucksack has space for tent and Trangia (parts of) on arrival – as group kit will be shared between you

Jacket – waterproof and windproof	Whistle
Waterproof over trousers	Torch and spare batteries
2 fleece tops or similar	Personal first aid kit inc blister pack
2-4 t shirts –(thermal optional)	Expedition food including emergency ration
2 walking trousers (not jeans)	Water bottles – 2 litres minimum
1 pair shorts – if appropriate	Cutlery
Underwear	Plate / bowl
Nightwear	Mug
Hat – warm or sunhat as appropriate	Box matches in waterproof container
Gloves if appropriate	Wash kit/ personal hygiene items
Gaiters – optional	Sunscreen
Rucksack	Towel
Roll Mat	Emergency money (optional)
